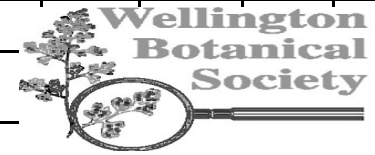


**Native Vascular Plants of Great Barrier Island**
